## Biosecurity inspections

### Request for AAT to attend Biosecurity inspection

If you wish AAT to attend Biosecurity inspection on your behalf please use the following procedure.

- Email [Department of Agriculture and Water Resources](mailto:Department of Agriculture and Water Resources) to book a time (preferably between 8-11am) [bdo@agriculture.gov.au](mailto:bdo@agriculture.gov.au) 1800 900 090
- Contact AAT via [clerks.fi@aaterminals.com.au](mailto:clerks.fi@aaterminals.com.au) to request attendance.
- In order for us to action your email promptly, in the 'Subject' line please put 'Attendance request,/Vessel name/Bill of Lading' and attach the Biosecurity Entry doc and advise of preferred QAP if unit requires further treatment.
- Attendance charges will be \$100+GST which must be paid prior to attendance.

### Clients attending their own Biosecurity inspection

- Email notification to be sent to [contractors.fi@aaterminals.com.au](mailto:contractors.fi@aaterminals.com.au) advising who will be attending, cargo to be inspected, vessel, voy number, bill of lading number. Notification to be sent 24hrs prior to access required
- Must be an MSIC Holder
- Site Induction to be completed - <http://www.inductee.com.au/aat/login.php>. Please print Completion Certificate and present to Security on arrival
- Register on AAT's Contractor Management System (ACSIS)
- Safe Work Instructions (must be presented upon request)
- PPE (Hi-Vis vest and steel cap boots)
- Restrictions: No vehicle access, Working at heights permit may be required

On arrival at Terminal please report to the Operations office to confirm location of cargo.
