

## **CERTIFICATION OF USED MOBILE MACHINERY & VEHICLES**

Prior to receiving used mobile machinery & vehicles into the AAT facility, the shipper must provide the following documentation to the AAT R&D office at time of receival:

- 1. Certification that the machine is mechanically sound and in full working order
- 2. Operators manual on how to drive the machine; OR a diagram identifying the usage of all controls and switches including the start and emergency shutdown device, if applicable.

AAT R&D shall complete an Export Sticker and Rear Vision Mirror Tag identifying any existing faults. Transport driver affixes both to the machine.

## If the machine requires cleaning, the Shipper must make arrangements to clean PRIOR to receival.

**If the machine is not operational**, the shipper must confirm alternative measures to export the machine with the shipping line i.e. use of MAFI trailer **PRIOR** to receival.

## The machine/vehicle will NOT be received if:

- It is leaking any type of fluid
- Is excessively dirty
- Has exposed wiring
- Has a deployed airbag
- Has any form of hazardous material (blood, intravenous needles, broken glass)
